STEP 1:

Ensure you meet graduate admission requirements

- General **university** admission requirements
 - U.S. Bachelor's degree or foreign degree equivalent to a 4-year U.S. bachelor's degree
 - English proficiency (non-native speakers of English) TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo, Country exemption, or earned degree from U.S. institution
- Academic **program** admission requirements
 - letters of recommendation
 - statement of purpose
 - writing sample
 - test scores (i.e., GRE, GMAT, etc.)
 - portfolio, etc.



Program Application Deadlines

Academic **programs establish their own application deadlines**, so be sure to research these on the program information pages to ensure that you are applying by the program's application deadline.

Also, **some academic programs only admit applicants for specific terms** (e.g. fall term). Again, check the [academic program](#) for deadline, term, and **contact information**.

Wayne State University Graduate School accepts online applications through **BusinessCAS** (Mike Ilitch School of Business), **EngineeringCAS** (College of Engineering), and **GradCAS** (all other programs).

Students complete the CAS online application by uploading an unofficial transcript and CV/resume (foreign transcripts must be translated). Upon submission of your CAS application, you will receive credentials to continue the application process where you can upload your statement of purpose, letters of recommendation, English proficiency and other test scores, and other required documents.

STEP 2: (continued)

Complete a graduate admissions application

Create a CAS account to start the application

1. Select your program
2. Provide personal information
3. Enter academic history and upload **unofficial transcript** (foreign transcripts must be translated)
4. Upload **CV/resume**



STEP 3:

Enter your fee waiver coupon code

- By attending today's Virtual Information Session that began at 4:30pm ET, you will receive an application fee waiver via email within a few days. It will be good for **one program application**.
- This email will provide you the fee waiver code, along with instructions on **applying it to your CAS application**.
- Digitally **sign the application to submit**



Receive Credentials for Uploading Materials

Once you submit your CAS application, you will receive another email with login credentials to a portal for **uploading your *required* program materials**.



STEP 4:

Upload program materials

- Using your login credentials, access the application portal to upload admission materials, which may include:
 - Letters of recommendation
 - Statement of purpose
 - Writing sample
 - Portfolio
 - Test scores (i.e., English proficiency, GRE, GMAT, etc.)
 - Prerequisite courses
 - Licensing requirements



Step 5:

Check your application and admission status

- Once your materials are uploaded, you will receive an email stating that your application is “**in review with your academic program.**” At this time, if you have questions on requirements or the time to admission decision, contact your [program of interest](#) direct.
- You may check the status of your application at any time by using your login credentials.

Your Decision Letter

You will receive an email stating that “**a decision has been made on your application,**” prompting you to login to your application to view the decision letter. **A decision letter will not be mailed.**

Finalize your admission

- Request Official transcripts
 - Degree-posted w/conferral date
 - Foreign students (and domestic students graduating with a bachelor's degree from a *foreign* institution) must submit an academic evaluation

- Request official test scores (School Code 1898)
- Foreign students, see **Step 6**



STEP 6: *Foreign Applicants Only*

Upload financial support documents (I-20)

Financial support documents

- Fellowship, assistantship, scholarship letter(s)
- Personal financial support docs
 - Bank Statement
 - Financial Affidavit of Support
