### Insurance Values:

Insurance rates typically change in **January** after the rates for the calendar year are announced

### Tuition Values:

Tuition rates typically change in **July**

9-month appointments - 20 graduate credits (10 per Fall and Winter semesters)

12-month appointments - 22 graduate credits (10 per Fall and Winter semesters and 2 per S/S semester\*)

\*In an effort to maintain uniformity among all graduate assistantships, the S/S semester tuition scholarship is now two graduate credits, consistent with the GEOC/AFT Labor Agreement. This means that letters of offer for all 12-month GRAs and GSAs should indicate a maximum scholarship of two graduate credits for the S/S semester. However, faculty members supporting GRAs on their grants may choose to pay more than the two graduate credits during the S/S semester.
