Terminology

- Internal funding funding that comes from any source within the university
 - The Graduate School
 - School or College
 - Department or Program
- External funding from any source outside the university (NIH, NSF, NEH, private foundations, corporations, foreign government, etc.)

Wayne State Graduate School Scholarships you apply

Graduate Professional Scholarships (200+)

- Covers up to 10 tuition credits at the in-state graduate school rate in Fall and Winter terms
- Students must be registered for at least 6 credits each term
 Application deadline: March 1

AGRADE Master's Scholarships (~50)

- For Wayne State alumni who participated in AGRADE as undergrads and are about to start their <u>first Masters-only semester</u>
- Covers up to 4 tuition credits at the in-state graduate school rate for Fall and Winter terms.

Wayne State Graduate School Scholarships by-nomination

Students are nominated by their program and selected by their school/college. No separate application is required.

- Master's Scholarships for Recruitment/Retention (~100)
 - Partial tuition scholarship for Fall and Winter term
- Dean's Diversity Master's Scholarship (~10)
 - Tuition scholarship for new Master's students.
- Dean's Merit Scholarships (~50)
 - \$3,000 tuition credit per semester for up to 4 semesters, for international master's students participating in a 3+2 agreement.

Other WSU scholarships and grants

- WSU Scholarship Opportunities
 - An online clearinghouse of private awards available to current WSU students through WSU schools and colleges
 - You may apply as soon as you are admitted
 - Scholarship amounts vary
 - Deadline: March 1



How can I get nominated? Ask!

- Contact your graduate program director
- Let them know you are actively seeking funding, and would like to be considered.
- Meet with them each semester you are in the program, and ask again!



Graduate Assistantships

- Ask your program
 - Not all programs have GTA, GRA or GSAs
 - Many GTA/GRA positions go to PhD students, some also go to master's students
- Benefits include stipend, tuition coverage and subsidized health insurance
- Application process varies by program



Financial aid

- Federal Student Aid and FAFSA
- Before applying for or accepting any scholarship or fellowship, consult with the <u>WSU Office of Financial</u> <u>Aid</u> regarding how such an award may affect your financial aid package, including loan eligibility.
