

Before You Apply...



Know the Preferred Application Deadlines*

Semester	Domestic students	Canadian and international students
Fall (Begins in Aug.)	Apply by June 1	Apply by May 1
Winter (Begins in Jan.)	Apply by Oct. 1	Apply by Sept. 1
Spring/summer (Spring begins in May; summer in June)	Apply by Feb. 1	Apply by Jan. 1



^{*}application deadlines may vary by academic program

International Applicants: Know the Transcript (Academic) Evaluation Deadlines

- Fall July 31
- Winter November 30
- Spring/Summer April 30








Basic Grad School Application Requirements

- 1. Apply online
- 2. \$50 non-refundable application fee OR application fee waiver
- 3. Proof of bachelor's degree (or 4-year U.S. equivalent)
- 4. Upload unofficial transcript from each post-secondary institution
- 5. GPA of 2.75 for master's program; 3.0 for doctoral
- 6. Proof of English proficiency (i.e., TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo, degree from TOEFL exempt country)



- Upload unofficial transcripts and English proficiency test score reports
- Enter the email address for each of your recommenders (if applicable)
- Pay the application fee or request a fee waiver
- Upload supplemental program requirements
- Submit your Application

- Test scores sent directly from TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo, GRE, GMAT
- Proof of Citizenship and Permanent Residency
