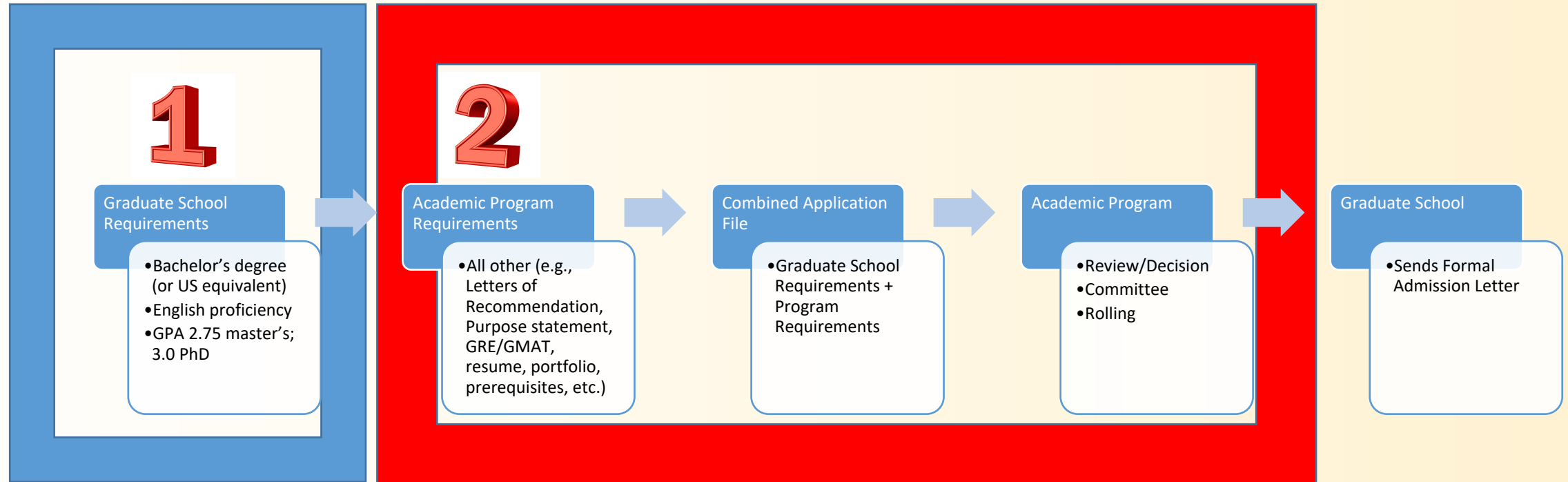

Spring/summer (Spring begins in May; summer in June)	Apply by Feb. 1	Apply by Jan. 1




# Basic Grad School Application Requirements

1. Apply online
2. \$50 non-refundable application fee OR application fee waiver
3. Proof of bachelor's degree (or 4-year U.S. equivalent)
4. Upload unofficial transcript from each post-secondary institution
5. GPA of 2.75 for master's program; 3.0 for doctoral
6. Proof of English proficiency (i.e., TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo, degree from TOEFL exempt country)

### Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT)

Most prospective graduate business students will take the GMAT or GRE, although, the Mike Ilitch School of Business does offer GMAT waivers to highly qualified applicants.

To be considered for a GMAT waiver for admission into the Master of Business Administration (M.B.A.) program, you must meet the minimum GPA requirement for graduate admission and one of the following criteria:

- An acceptable score on the Graduate Record Examinations (GRE), Law School Admission Test (LSAT) or Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) entrance exam
- GPA of 3.0 or higher from an AACSB-accredited business program
- GPA of 3.2 or higher from a regionally-accredited university in any major
- A minimum 2.75 GPA **and** at least three years of relevant professional experience that shows increased responsibility over that period

To be considered for a GMAT waiver for admission into the Master of Science in Accounting (M.S.A.) program, you must meet one of the following criteria:

- GPA of 3.0 or higher from an AACSB-accredited business program
- GPA of 3.2 or higher from a regionally-accredited university in any major
- GMAT **cannot** be waived based on work experience.

There is no need to request a GMAT/GRE waiver from the Graduate Programs Office. Once your application is reviewed and determined to have met one of the above criteria for test waiver consideration, the application will be pulled and reviewed for an admission decision. If the application is reviewed and an applicant is determined to need a GMAT/GRE for admission into the graduate program, a member of the Graduate Programs Office staff will provide feedback on the application indicating so.
